- II. Approval of Minutes – April 17th, 2024
 - a. Motion by DeCesari to approve April 17, 2024, minutes. Second Millinger. Motion carried.
- III. Recognition of Members and Guests
 - a. Scott Goley addressed board regarding new construction ECC application.
- IV. Finance Report – Given by Rice
 - a. As of April 30, 2024, we had \$643,174.63 in the Operating Account and \$200,033.42 in Reserve Account.
 - b. Motion by Pedigo to approve Finance Report. Second Millinger. Motion carried.
- V. General Manager Report – Rice
 - a. Pool-Pass Program up and running, pool/beach opening procedures are in full swing, requested permission to take newspaper back to old template and provided formatted Sponsorship Proposal.

 - a. Blue Book Committee – No Report
 - i. Meeting next Monday at 6:30pm

 - i. Surfacing for the new courts are scheduled for the 23rd

SUMMER REMINDERS/ANNOUNCEMENTS

BOATING REGULATIONS

- Only water craft owned by Lake Camelot Subdivision lot owners and members of Camelot Round Table Association who are in good standing, will be allowed on the lakes.
- Any watercraft deemed unsafe by the RTA Board will not be allowed or registered for use on the lakes.
- The number of persons carried, load carried, equipment shall be in accordance with the U.S. Coast Guard Regulations and builder's recommendations.
- No boat will be allowed on the lakes after sundown without proper lights. These lights must be turned on from dusk to dawn.
- For Lake Camelot (Upper Lake) all gasoline powered engines must be raised or covered. Boat motors can be used for loading boats onto trailers at launch areas.
- On Lake Lancelot (Lower Lake) traffic flow for all watercraft must be in a counter-clockwise direction.
- Watercraft occupants will not deposit debris of any kind into the waters of the lakes or dock areas.
- Deliberate wake jumping by boats and personal watercraft shall not be permitted.
- Every boat operator is required to know and follow the regulations of the State of Illinois Boat Registration and Safety Act, the U.S. Coast Guard and the Department of Natural Resources. The preceding regulations are incorporated by reference into the Rules and Regulations, and therefore, any violation shall be considered a violation of the Rules and Regulations.
- Any watercraft of a property owner that is propelled by oar, paddle, foot pedals, sail or mechanical motor must be registered with the RTA annually. To register a craft, the standard RTA registration form and the Lake Camelot Watercraft Acknowledgement form must be completed and submitted annually along with:
 - The original registration issued by Illinois, and a certificate of marine public liability and property damage insurance if the craft is equipped with a motor exceeding 10 horsepower.

POOL/BEACH/AMENITY USE

- RTA members are now able to bring their grandchildren to the pool without paying a guest fee.
- If RTA members have a regular babysitter/nanny/childcare provider for their children, they may register the childcare provider with the RTA Office so that the childcare provider may take the RTA member's children to the pool and beach without charge. Please note that they MUST be registered with the office, this cannot be done at the pool or beach entry. This allows access for the childcare provider only when the RTA member's children are present with them.
- We are utilizing a program called Pool-Pass for pool entry this season. Each member will need to get a picture taken for the program. The pool staff are equipped with iPads to take photos at pool entry, however you have the option to stop in the office to take care of this as well. Please be sure to stop in the office to register everyone in your household for amenity use.
- RTA Membership will be checked at the beach with the same information inputted into the Pool-Pass program.
- As a reminder, if members are delinquent for their dues, fines, etc. they do not have access to any of the amenities - this includes the pool, park, courts, beach, and lakes.
